

COACHING FOR EQUITY IN COMPUTER SCIENCE

The **National Center for Computer Science Education (NCCSE)** and **Code Savvy** are joining forces to provide coaching programs with a focus on equity for CS educators across the country.

There will be two programs which will provide summer professional development sessions to train coaches who will then work with teachers over the academic year.

Code Savvy - MN High School Teachers

- Hiring 18 coaches - \$5,700 stipend each
- Coaches will train 36 teachers - \$750 stipend

NCCSE - AP CS High School Teachers (nationwide)

- Hiring 18 coaches - \$5,700 stipend each
- Coaches will train 36 teachers - \$750 stipend

Eligibility:

- Be a U.S. educator (includes territories)
- Will be teaching high school CS in the next academic year (either stand-alone or integrated)
- Be located in MN (required by Code Savvy)
- Teaching AP CS specifically in the next academic year (required by NCCSE)
